TALKING TO YOUR PET? YOU CAN...ACTUALLY!

"A snake communicates with a lion through telepathy and a monkey will communicate with a horse in the same way. Telepathy is the main language of communication among animals and through telepathy it is also possible for humans to communicate with animals," said Poncelet while talking to *Qatar Tribune*.

EGLISH teacher Sara Lawrence, Jordanian national Boral al Tarifi along with half a dozen participants, had come to learn the art or science of communicating with animals at a day-long workshop, organised by Belgian national Sabine Poncelet, an experienced alternative therapist, who believes that animals can be talked through telepathy.

"A snake communicates with a lion through telepathy and a monkey will communicate with a horse in the same way. Telepathy is the main language of communication among animals and through telepathy it is also possible for humans to communicate with animals," said Poncelet while talking to *Qatar Tribune*.

"I usually get responses from people, '...you speak to animals... are you crazy or what?' It is because of the fact that usually people are not aware that talking to animals is possible until they study animal communication. Animals show certain responses such as moving their ears or wagging their tail in a certain fashion, which most of us can't understand but if we learn their language i.e. telepathy then we can easily communicate with precision," she said.

Besides teaching communication with the animals, the workshop also raised awareness about animals being sentient beings. They may not be human beings but they have feeling, emotions and are capable of loving us that many people do not realise, or tend to ignore.

In the absence of such awareness, we tend to ignore that fact that animals mostly suffer because of us (humans), yet their owners do not understand their feelings. Through this workshop, participants learned communication with animals, which will let them talk to their pets and to know their problems, thus making them responsible owners.

Animals show unconditional love to mankind and they have an ability to absorb the negative energy of humans. To

this effect they can also be healers. There are innumerable instances where animals have died for the sake of human beings and because of their unconditional loyalty towards their owners.

"I have developed this course through extensive research and study about animal communication. All of us have a potential to learn animal communication and also an ability to talk to the animals and this step-by-step study guarantees participants to be able to communicate with any animal," said Poncelet.

Apart from being the most known and successful animal healer in the region, she is no less successful as a trustworthy hypnotist, past life regression therapist, theta healer and a life coach. Interestingly, Poncelet is also into finance, having worked for more than 15 years in corporate finance.

But long before her stint in finance, she had the realisation that she could communicate with animals, when as a 7-year-old girl, she could actually talk to a local cow. There was hardly any buyer for her story about her extraordinary faculty of communication with animals. "When I told my mother about my ability to talk to the cow, she laughed," Poncelet said.

However, this didn't lessen her zest for exploring the field of animal communication. She started delving deeper into this subject by the time she was 18 years old. Animal communication was her weekend and off-duty job passion. Her services were extended to friends and acquaintances on a purely amateurish basis.

She came to Dubai in 2011 to work as a finance manager but before long she lost that job. "As if my life was destined for a change, most of my job applications went unanswered which had never happened before, and everything was signalling me to explore the territory that I always wanted to work in," she said.

"I made up my mind to pursue my passion and work as a dedicated animal communicator. She started working for a rescue association in 2011 but the income was not enough to survive in a city like Dubai, which led me to form my own company.

"My first workshop took place in 2013 with the attendance of 7 participants. Animal communication through telepathy is the field which is very popular in USA, UK and South Africa but it's still developing in this part of the world," said Poncelet.

American national Sara Lawrence, an English language teacher who had participated in the workshop said, "I was interested to know more about animal communication. According to Poncelet there are two levels of communication with an animal: the basic or the behavioural and the advance, such as telepathy. It is the second level that we focused on during this workshop which was an eye-opener for me.

"I have been communicating with my cat on both the levels and our relation has stayed on for 13 years. I surely feel that through this workshop, my relations with my cat will be even better." According to Sara, she got very sick last November and her cat helped her by soaking in all her negative energy and her disease, which helped Sara recover, but in the bargain, the cat herself got sick.

"My cat was close to dying in spite of all the consultations with the best vets and then one of the vets advised me to meet Poncelet. When Poncelet had a telepathic conversation with the cat, she came to know that cat had an infection because of the fact that she has been picking up Sara's disease and as a result, the cat's own energy went down to an extent that she fell ill. The cat dramatically started recovering after Poncelet's intervention," she said.

Boral on the other hand testified, "I was extremely sceptical when I joined the workshop, thinking that it was a waste of time and money. Both during the course I was convinced and started to believe in what Poncelet taught. I had some behavioural issues with my cat at home and thought maybe Poncelet's workshop would help me gain an insight into her psyche. And surprisingly it worked so well with my cat and she is now the cutest cat in the world. Poncelet's methodology is so simple and easy to understand that it can be implemented in a very effective and straightforward way for any animal."

Boral, who is travelling soon, is relatively less apprehensive in keeping her cat in a pet dormitory, for she can now telepathically talk to inmates to see if animals give a positive feel-back about the pet care centre. "Only on the testimony of inmates I will leave my cat," she said in excitement.

It has been more than five years now that Poncelet has shared her knowledge and healing power throughout Europe, UAE and Qatar, having healed and assisted hundreds of people and animals and brought harmony in their lives.
